Stronger Together: Mining Community Voices at MI26

How to Prepare and Record Your Video Submission

What We're Looking For

We invite a **3-5 minute original video**, recorded in **horizontal (landscape) format**, that shares your personal or community perspective on this year's theme:

"Stronger Together: Progress Through Partnership"

Your story should connect this theme to **real issues**, **experiences**, **or opportunities** from your community or context — especially those affected by mining.

You don't need fancy equipment. A mobile phone, natural light, and your voice are enough.

Suggested Structure

While you're free to speak from the heart, here's a simple structure to guide your message:

1. Introduce yourself

Name, country, and your role or connection to a mining-affected community

2. Share your message

- What are the challenges or opportunities you see related to mining?
- What does "Stronger Together" mean to you and your community?
- What needs to change? Who should listen?

3. Offer a vision

- What partnerships could create a better future for your community?
- What actions do you hope to inspire?

4. Sign off

- A closing message or call to action
- Feel free to speak in your authentic voice and tone



Recording Tips

Format & Orientation

- Record in horizontal (landscape) format
- Do not record in portrait (vertical) mode

Framing & Camera Position

- Frame your face **from the shoulders up**, centered in the screen
- Place the camera at **eye level** (use books or a stand if needed)

Lighting

- Face a window or light source (avoid having light behind you)
- Natural light works best

Audio

- Record in a quiet place with minimal background noise
- Speak clearly. If available, use an external mic or headset

Quality

- Use a phone, laptop webcam, or camera capable of recording at 720p or higher
- Do a quick test recording to check sound and lighting

Submission Requirements

• Length: 3 to 5 minutes

• Format: MP4 or MOV

• **Resolution**: Minimum 720p (1280x720)

• Language: English or French

• **Ownership**: The video must be your **original work**. You must have permission to include any other people shown.

If your video is hosted (e.g. on YouTube, Google Drive), you may also submit a **link** instead of a direct file upload.



Helpful Reminders

- Speak honestly and from your lived experience
- Avoid scripts speak naturally as if talking to a friend
- Submissions that are blurry, too quiet, or poorly lit may not be considered
- You must **own all rights** to your video. Do not include copyrighted music or visuals
